

New management at Nürnberger-Spielkarten-Verlag

The management of Nürnberger-Spielkarten-Verlag GmbH will change on 31.12.2022. The longstanding Managing Director Franz Jurthe will leave the NSV and hand over the management to Tobias Husch, Head of Finance, by the end of the year.

In 2000, Franz Jurthe took up the position of managing director at the Nürnberger-Spielkarten-Verlag and had a decisive influence on the successful development of the publishing house. Among other things, he introduced author's games into the programme and thus created the foundation of today's image of the NSV. With several nominations for "Spiel des Jahres" (Game of the Year) and other awards, the Nürnberger-Spielkarten-Verlag established itself with its simple card and dice games. Today, the dice game QWIXX and the excellent card games THE GAME and THE MIND are considered classics of the game scene.

"During his many years of business, Franz Jurthe has always used new opportunities and demonstrated his sense for games and the market. Communication with business partners and the customers' needs have always been his top priority. We would like to thank Franz Jurthe very much for his successful work and passion over the last 20 years and wish him all the best for the future," says Tobias Husch. "With an enhanced focus on our author games, we want to maintain these values and work. Together with our new distribution partner, Cartamundi Deutschland GmbH, we want to continue the course of the NSV as well as expand and strengthen the publishing programme with new ideas."

On 1st of September 2022, Cartamundi Deutschland GmbH exclusively took over the distribution of the NSV's game assortment for Germany and Austria within the framework of a distribution partnership. In addition, as of 1st of December 2022, the Nürnberger-Spielkarten-Verlag discontinued the long-standing business of promotional card and promotional game production, in order to focus more on the development and expansion of author games.
